

# TIMETABLE

- 8.00-8.30am. PoC meeting to discuss the plan for the day, including any issues we need to be aware of, summary (highlight) of pupil's behaviour and attendance since the last lesson, and cover off any administrative and logistical points.
- 8.30-P1. Lesson set up (IT, Equipment)
- P1 – Group 1 (rotate weekly)
- P2 – Group 2 (rotate weekly)
- Lunch. Activity (30min) for the target year group. Non-trial pupils to be involved. activities during the lunch period will be fluid regarding the pupil's involvement, meaning pupils can drop in-out throughout the activity to cater for lunch periods/toilet breaks etc... Max 15 pupils (1 x support staff required)\*
- P3 – Group 3 (rotate weekly)
- P4 – Group 4 (rotate weekly)
- After school club (45min). Open to all pupils in the target year group. Booking required for this session, although it will be open to all. Max 15 pupils (no staff required) The group will change after \*
- Before leaving. The instructor will highlight any key points from the day to the PoC, and give a summary for the following week regarding any specific requirements.
- \*The activities for both lunchtime and after school will be practical and based on Character development, although the structure is less about gaining a deeper understanding of this, and more about the pupils building relationships and creating structure during an 'unstructured' period within school. The 'mini-missions' could be looked at as a 'small team game' which brings activity and fluidity to the task.
